



Community Needs Assessment – Data Analysis

Objective:

The project intern team will

- Synthesize the data collected from previous year's reports on the community health assessment in North Richmond (Fort Bend County). The project intern is not expected to collect data in the field nor analyze data.
- Conduct a desk review to create a final report (no more than 7-8 pages) by compiling, editing, and rewriting a summary of multiple years of reports on the community health assessment in North Richmond (Fort Bend County).

Deliverable:

Goals:

- The main audience for this report is the organizations, nonprofits and foundations that serve North Richmond. The intent of creating this report is to provide information to the stakeholders mentioned so that they can make decisions and set aside resources for programming in North Richmond.

Requirements:

- Interns are expected to work with mentor(s) to understand the data analysis that was conducted and the report creation process following the guidelines.

Results:

- The interns will produce a final 7–8-page report which will contain the most pertinent data, statements from interviewees, summary of descriptions and infographics. A few examples of professional-looking community health assessment reports will be provided to set expectations.

Deliverables:

- Mandatory in-person final project presentation to summarize the outcomes of the community assessment report, challenges faced and proposed solutions.
- A final community health assessment report where three years of data are synthesized into one document. The intern is encouraged to use infographics to enhance the presentation of data in their report.
