



U&I Red Cross Navigator Blood Transportation Project

Objective:

The intern is

- Expected to transport the blood from the Red-Cross facility to the Hospital.
- Provide assistance during the transportation as a blood navigator.

Goals: The intern will be responsible for understanding and following the strict procedures related to ambulatory transportation of blood bags from the Red Cross location in specified containers to the designated hospital.

Requirements:

- Background Check: The intern or the legal guardian who would be driving the Red Cross van would need to undergo Red Cross Specific background check and MVR check.
- Mandatory Training and Orientation with the Blood Transportation lead
- Interns are expected to have a legal guardian or U&I registered team member with a valid driver's license to drive them to the facility at all times.
- Type of Vehicle: A minivan or a passenger van (provided by American Red Cross).

Results:

Final report to be submitted that captures:

- What is the need for blood transportation?
- What has been achieved?
- How has it benefited the community?
- What are some future actions that come out of this project?

Deliverables:

- Mandatory in-person final project presentation to summarize the outcomes of the project and challenges faced, proposed solutions
